Connection & Belonging Across Cultures

Imagine you are a stranger in a strange land. How will you find your way? Who will you connect with as you navigate this new place? Now imagine you are home. You have found your people. You know just what to say to get what you need. Communication—written, spoken, and unspoken—helps us navigate worlds both familiar and unfamiliar. In this learning community, which combines two in-person courses, Introduction to Interpersonal Communication (COM 104) and Composition I (ENG 101), we'll look at how communication needs change in different contexts, and how the communities and norms we're born into (or choose to join) shape our view of the world. Together, we'll explore local and global communities and apply core concepts of communication and composition to better understand our world, our place in it, and how to find (and create) a sense of belonging for ourselves and others.

Students must register for both **ENG 101-A1** and **COM 104-A1**, taught by Nell McCabe and Mary Dickman.
