Experience college and earn credits before you complete high school, through BCC's **Bridge to College** program. Berkshire County high school seniors may enroll in college courses, free of charge. BCC will waive tuition and fees. You may take one college level course per semester, for which you meet the prerequisites at BCC's main campus, South County Center, McCann High School, or Intermodal Center, including on-line offerings.
