Position Overview: Under the supervision of the Dean of Nursing, Health & Social Sciences and reporting to the Director of Nursing, the Nursing Lab & Patient Simulation Assistant is responsible for providing assistance to the Practical Nursing program and Patient Simulation Center by:

- Collaborating with faculty to assist in reinforcing lab skills and providing students with additional time to practice skills.
- Working with faculty to prepare students for competency testing.
- Assisting with set up, break down, and maintenance of equipment and materials for specific simulation events.
- Providing assistance to students and faculty using simulation as required.
- Working with the Simulation Specialist to assist in the organization and maintenance of all patient simulation supplies and requisition supplies as needed.
- Maintaining safety standards with regard to use of equipment and hazardous waste disposal.
- Performing related work as directed.

Qualifications: Associate degree or higher in nursing. Recent clinical experience in acute or long-term care. Fluency in computer applications including, but not limited to Microsoft applications, required. Ability to learn all aspects of hi-fidelity patient simulation required. Experience using patient simulation and using patient simulation software, preferred.
