Position Overview: Provide classroom instruction in psychology to a diverse student population. Primary instructional responsibilities and assignments will be in a variety of aspects within psychology, including introductory level and upper level psychology courses (ability to teach social psychology and adolescent psychology a plus). Faculty typically provide 15 credit hours of classroom instruction each semester. Assist in delivery and maintenance of psychology course-work and program needs including development and preparation of course and assessment materials. Participate in college service, professional development, and student advisement activities.

Qualifications: Master's degree required, Master's in psychology or equivalent coursework preferred. Candidate must demonstrate depth in discipline as evidenced by academic preparation and prior college teaching experience, preferably at the community college level. Commitment to student-centered, outcomes-based education with experience incorporating multiple instructional strategies and the use of technology in teaching and learning. Excellent written and interpersonal skills required. Experience with on-line teaching preferred.
