



Student Right to Know Disclosure

Berkshire Community College (BCC) is pleased to provide the following information regarding the institution's graduation and transfer-out rates. This information is provided in compliance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended. The rates reflect the graduation and transfer-out status of students who enrolled during the Fall 2021 semester and for whom 150% of the normal time-to-completion has elapsed.

During the 2021 fall semester, 142 **first-time and full-time**, certificate or degree-seeking undergraduate students entered BCC. After three years, at 150% of the normal time to completion for this cohort, 20% of these students graduated or completed their programs, and 19% transferred to other institutions of higher education.

In order to provide a more representative account of student outcomes, Table 1 shows graduation and transfer rates, at the 4-year, 6-year and 8-year mark, for **first-time and full-time** students and also for **first-time and part-time** students enrolled during the 2016 fall semester.
