1. Apply to BCC (Admissions Office, 499-4660, Ext. 1630) to Pre-Surgical Technology Program

- Submit application;
- Submit official high school transcript(s) OR GED/HISET;
- Submit official transcripts of any previous colleges attended.

2. Complete A.S. Surgical Technology program admission requirements

- Complete summer course AHS 107 Introduction to Surgical Technology with a B (83) or higher
 - Note: this course requires immunization and health verification be completed prior to the start of class. See attached for immunization and health verification requirements
- Immunization and medical records remain current through the completion of Surgical Technology I course
- Admission on a rolling basis

3. Applying to McCann Postsecondary Surgical Tech Program

- Students are eligible to apply to McCann after completing all BCC coursework with a minimum GPA of 2.0 and grade of B (83) or higher in AHS 117 Surgical Technology I
- Admissions requires an interview and space availability with McCann
- Criminal Offender Record Information (CORI) required. Any prior criminal offense could hinder acceptance to McCann

Note: Program and General Education courses may have pre-requisite or co-requisite course requirements.
