#### Important Information

Students who have met all admission requirements must have an application received by November 1st to be considered for admission for the spring semester. Admission decisions are made in November and students are notified of their acceptance by mail/email.

Acceptance into the ADN bridge program is determined on a space available basis in order of application submission. While published minimum standards may have been met, it does not guarantee admission.

A minimum of 5 seats will be reserved for current BCC Practical Nursing (PN) students who will be considered for admission contingent upon successful completion of program requirements subsequent to students currently holding a PN license.
